Further Advice From Your Insurance Advocate

Keep In Mind That Most Claims Can Wait To Be Reported.

The key is to focus on SAFETY FIRST then to proceed as you can to take steps to stop the damage from getting worse.

Our best advice:

- If you have evacuated, do not enter your home if you see significant structural damage
- If you can do so safely, document the situation by taking photos
- If you have an active leak, do what you can safely to stop them and prevent further damage
- If you have power, run your air conditioner to dehumidify your home
- Prepare a list of damage or lost items for your adjuster
- If you are reporting a claim, be sure to make a note of the claim adjuster's name and telephone number
- Keep damaged items (or portions of them) aside until the claims adjuster has visited your home
- If you are unable to return home right away, be sure to keep your receipts to help with the claims process
- If you need help with restoration, ask your insurance carrier to provide recommendations

Driving After The Storm

Be sure you are on high alert when driving after the storm:

- Look for downed power lines and avoid them
- Traffic lights will not be working and street signs may have blown down so err on the side of caution
- Do not drive through standing water, even just six inches will reach the bottom of most passenger cars causing stalling or a loss of control
- A car that has been submerged in water will likely have engine damage, do not start it until you are confident key systems have been drained of water
